Funding incentives available to cover the full cost of tuition, books, tools and supplies.

The Applied Electrical Installation certificate program is accredited by Apprenticeship Manitoba. Graduates who meet the requirements and register as an apprentice within two years of finishing the program will receive credit for Level 1 in-school training and 900 hours in the Construction, Industrial or Power Electrician apprenticeship program.

Admission Requirements

- » A complete Manitoba Grade 12 or equivalent
- » Consumer/Essential Mathematics 40S or equivalent

Note: While those who meet admission requirements will be accepted into the program on a first-qualified, first-accepted basis, only those who meet CIGan's funding requirements will receive funding.

Funding Eligibility Requirements

Funding incentives, made available through CIGan's Unlocking Pre-Apprenticeship Pathways and the Congress of Aboriginal Peoples, are available for people who are underrepresented in the skilled trades.

Those eligible for funding incentives may be eligible for additional funding, directly from CIGan, based on a needs assessment.

Hands-on, in-school training for 22 weeks, including a 120-hour work placement.
