Qualifications:

Conditions of Employment:

- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Must possess valid Class 5F driver's licence (with the ability to upgrade to Class 3 within 1 year of hire), must complete MOPIA certification (within 1 year of hire), training provided. Must successfully complete Marine Emergency Duties (within 1 year of hire), training provided.
- Ability to work extended hours or overtime; travel and work within the province of Manitoba by ground, water or air transportation and remain at remote work sites for extended periods.
- Ability to perform the physical requirements of the job, and able to work in confined spaces, and perform work over/around water.
- Must possess Interprovincial Journeyman Heavy Duty Mechanic, Diesel Mechanic, or Agricultural Mechanic Certificate.
- Ability to work with paints, solvents, or chemicals.
- Must be able to wear and maintain required personal protective equipment.

Essential:

- Experience with the operation and repair of diesel and gasoline engines, and high pressure hydraulic.
- Experience with troubleshooting and diagnosing electrical and hydraulic operating systems.
- Experience with DC electrical systems and engine controls.
- Strong interpersonal skills to communicate effectively and courteously with internal contacts and stakeholders.
- Ability to work independently and demonstrate initiative.
- Ability to work in a team environment.

Along with the Operations Superintendent this position may lead the maintenance support staff in the delivery of maintenance and repair services. The Senior Marine Mechanic requires extensive interaction and co-operation with a diversity of internal and external contacts to ensure consistency in policy, standards, procedures and Federal Regulations to ensure Northern Airports and Marine Operations operational objectives are met.


