



## **The SilvaGro Partnership Co-op Opportunity**

The SilvaGro Partnership has an opportunity for Co-op students to work in our growing teams at our forest nursery facilities in Juniper Beach (near Kamloops) and Quesnel, B.C.

Reporting to the Grower, the Co-operative students will be a part of our growing and irrigation teams, with primary responsibility for the daily care of seedlings in greenhouse and outdoor compounds. You will have a good understanding of greenhouse environments and plant sciences, with an emphasis on seedling nutrition and cultural practices.

A basic knowledge of plant growth and nutrition is required, and good familiarity with Microsoft Excel and Word is desirable.

You should have completed at least one year of a degree or diploma course in Horticulture or Earth Sciences, and be seeking a career in Horticulture or Sustainability once you graduate.

This position is ideally for a four-month period, beginning in early May. We would hope to offer successful co-op students full-time employment upon graduation, with the objective of making them members of our year-round management team. You will be working with skilled seedling specialists, in one of the best forest nursery companies in Canada.

In operation since 1985, The SilvaGro Partnership produces 45 million seedlings annually for clients throughout the Western Provinces. We provide growing and cold storage services from two sites: an outdoor compound facility near Ashcroft, B.C., producing mainly pine seedlings, and a greenhouse facility in Quesnel growing primarily Spruce, Douglas Fir, and Larch trees.
