- Knowledge of safe working practices.
- Ability to keep and maintain written records.

### Desired qualifications include:

- Ability to work independently and with minimal supervision.
- Experience in grounds and building upkeep and janitorial work.
- Experience with common hand tools.

- Must be physically capable of performing all duties assigned to the position, including lifting weights of up to 50 pounds and working in various types of outdoor conditions.

Under the supervision of the Park Works Supervisor, the **Labourer** performs a variety of heavy and light manual duties associated with construction, maintenance, and works operations; including janitorial duties and general maintenance of grounds and facilities, and may be required to operate various small equipment and tools.

The **Operator** will be required to operate various equipment including specialized mowers, light motor vehicles, and other small equipment. The Operator may also be required to perform maintenance and minor repairs on equipment, as well as keep daily operating and maintenance records.
