- A Class 4 Operator's Certificate in Water Treatment Plants as issued by the Province of Manitoba or recognized equivalent;
- A Class 5 Power Engineering Certificate within twenty-four (24) months of appointment;
- A Class 4 Power Engineering Certificate within forty-two (42) months of appointment, and;
- Any additional certification required under Provincial guidelines and legislation.
