- Must be able to travel and work within the province of Manitoba by ground, water, and air transportation and remain at remote work sites for extended periods and work irregular hours.
- Must be able to handle physical requirements of the job and able to work in confined spaces, and perform work over/around water.
- Must successfully complete Marine Emergency Duties within 1 year of hire, training provided.
- Must have an Interprovincial Journeyman Heavy Duty Mechanic Licence or Truck Transport Mechanic Certificate, or Agriculture Mechanic Certificate.

Qualifications:

Essential:

- Extensive experience as a heavy duty mechanic in the areas of diagnostic, repair, and maintenance of diesel and gasoline engines as well as high pressure hydraulic systems.
- Experience with DC electrical systems and engine controls.


