The Butterfly Club – Program Facilitator

Ka Ni Kanichihk Inc. is seeking an innovative, motivated and engaged Facilitator for The Butterfly Club, as a positive role model for female-identified Indigenous youth, 9-13 years of age, in cultural, academic, environmental, and leadership activities. The program provides youth an opportunity to develop self-confidence, a sense of belonging, and involvement in things they may otherwise not have access to.

The program requires a commitment to the end of June 2018 in order to truly make a positive impact in these youth's lives.

The Facilitator is responsible for program facilitation, classroom management, creating lesson and meal plans, cooking program meals, and some safety planning, conflict prevention and resolution, as well as assisting the Coordinator in other tasks as assigned.

Qualifications

- Relevant post-secondary education, or combination of education and experience, in community or program facilitation, education, women and gender studies, Native studies, environment or sciences, social sciences, Canadian and Indigenous history
- Two (2) years' experience working with Indigenous youth
- Experience in program planning and delivery, youth engagement and leadership skills
- Knowledgeable about community resources
- Knowledge of and committed to addressing issues that female-identified Indigenous youth and adults experience
- High degree of resourcefulness, flexibility and adaptability
- Strong morals and ethics, along with a commitment to staff and participant confidentiality
- Excellent organizational, classroom management, and time management skills
- Must be prepared to work 20 hours a week with flexible hours including 2 evenings a week, and 1 weekend day a month
- Must provide a criminal record and child abuse registry check (*must be within 6 months*)

Assets

- Knowledge of Indigenous culture and spirituality
- Valid Manitoba Driver's License, clear drivers abstract and access to vehicle
- Food Safe certification
- Bilingual in an Indigenous language

Ka Ni Kanichihk is committed to achieving employment equity, therefore encourage Indigenous persons to apply and self-declare within their cover letter.
