

Spring Workers wanted for field work on Hop Farm.

- Prairie Mountain Hops is a 6 acre hop farm in Southern Manitoba growing quality hops for the craft BEER market
- We require up to 5 workers for approximately 3 weeks starting around mid-May.
- Duties are general spring work in the hop yard. Not limited to but including: tying of trellis strings, training of bines up trellis strings, some field scouting of pests.
- Responsibilities: applicant(S) would need to be able to get themselves to Boissevain by 7:30 am (ride sharing maybe available), bring your own lunch and snacks. (Drinks will be provided). Any tools needed for any job will be made available. Days will be at least a full 8 hours (depending on the weather) with a 30 minute lunch break as well as regular breaks.
