- fit to participate in multi-day wilderness backpacking/canoeing trips, and maintain energy and focus to support campers in physical and emotional obstacles
- certified in Standard First Aid or Wilderness First Aid (WFA) and Bronze Cross, or are willing to obtain
- able to provide an acceptable criminal background check
- able to join us between June 5, 2019 and August 30, 2019
