Reporting to the Water Treatment and Recovery Supervisor, the **Environmental Technician** is responsible for daily operations of environmental protection equipment and maintaining the requirements of Simplot's environmental license.

What your responsibilities will be:

- Ensuring that all company and plant environmental policies are adhered to, and is directly responsible for maintaining compliance with the facility's environmental license.
- Ensuring operation and monitoring requirements have been met for environmental protection systems.
- Ensuring that equipment is operated in a safe and efficient manner in order to maximize treatment efficiency and minimize treatment costs.
- Maintaining all equipment in good working order, or causes such maintenance as is required to be performed by competent people.
- Recognizing and responding to all troubleshooting situations.
- Entering required data into Manufacturing Management Suite [MMS] and other systems in an accurate and timely manner.
