

# COURSES OFFERED AT THE Centre for Adult Learning (CAL)



CAL offers flexible study options at Assiniboine campuses in Brandon and Dauphin so you can receive your high school diploma, improve existing marks, or take courses for college and university.

## 1. Choose when you'd like to start:

**Term 1** runs September to December. **Term 2** runs January to May. Evening classes may vary.

To avoid disappointment, apply for your seat as soon as you can. Classes fill up early and are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

In-person and hub-mode classes begin in September after the long weekend (Term 1) and in January after the winter break (Term 2). Registration for the term is not available after the first week of classes.

## 2. Decide which study option is right for you:

**In-person classes:** In-person means attending your classes on campus, where you will be able to work directly with instructors and peers. This option offers hands-on learning, real-time discussions, and access to campus resources.

**Hub Mode:** In Hub Mode, classes are taught in-person at a CAL location and streamed live to students who can join class from another site or from home. For example, an in-person class may be hosted at Victoria Avenue East campus in Brandon, but students living in Winnipeg may join from the convenience of their home. These students join the class using Zoom or Microsoft Teams. They can take part in class discussions and activities just like students in the room. Instructors can be reached by phone, email, through the online learning system (Moodle), or in person by appointment.

## 3. Choose your campus:

In **Brandon** at the Victoria Avenue East Campus or in **Dauphin** at the Parkland Campus.
