#### **CCOURSES OFFERED AT THE**

# **Centre for Adult Learning (CAL)**



CAL offers flexible study options at Assiniboine campuses in Brandon and Dauphin so you can receive your high school diploma, improve existing marks, or take courses for college and university.

#### 1. Choose when you'd like to start:

Term 1 runs September to December. Term 2 runs January to May

#### 2. Decide which study option is right for you:

*In-person classes:* In-person means attending your classes on campus, where you will be able to work directly with instructors and peers. This option offers hands-on learning, real-time discussions, and access to campus resources.

Independent Study (Continuous Registration): The Independent Study option lets students work on their own, at their own pace. There are no regular classes to attend, and most learning happens through written instructions. Students turn in their work by mail, email, the online learning system (LMS), or in person. This option is very flexible, but students are required to set a schedule for checking in and getting help when needed.

Independent Study courses allow students to start any time. Once they are enrolled, they have up to 12 months to complete the course.

Hub Mode: In Hub Mode, classes are taught in-person at a CAL location and streamed live to students who can join class from another site or from home. For example, an in-person class may be hosted at Victoria Avenue East campus in Brandon, but students living in Winnipeg may join from the convenience of their home. These students join the class using Zoom or Microsoft Teams. They can take part in class discussions and activities just like students in the room. Instructors can be reached by phone, email, through the online learning system (LMS), or in person by appointment.

In Brandon at the Victoria Avenue East Campus or in Dauphin at the Parkland Campus
