Estimated annual tuition represents the average cost for 2-year programs. All tuition and fees are listed in Canadian dollars (CAD).

- An * beside the tuition amount denotes a “cohort” program with non-refundable tuition fees that must be paid prior to the program start date, and are only eligible for a refund in the case of a study permit refusal prior to the start date of the program. - All international students in Manitoba are required to have health insurance at approximately up to \$1,150 per year, depending on the length of program. The college bills students for this directly and ensure they have the required insurance.
- For estimated book and supplies costs, visit the program webpage. Many programs have technology needs that require students to bring their own device or have one at home. Visit assiniboine.net/tech for details.
