DIGITAL AGRICULTURE FUNDAMENTALS

This program, funded by Palette Skills equipped students with practical skills in digital agriculture, including precision agriculture, GIS, AI, and data analytics. The program was designed to build new skills for those already working in the industry (upskill) or reskill those who were new to the agriculture industry but had strong transferable skills. The program concluded in 2026. New digital ag programs are being explored to continue building skills as digital agriculture advances in Manitoba.
