SWINE PRODUCTION FOUNDATIONS

16 to 32 weeks per course | Monthly start

 **Online**

If you like working with animals, enjoy working with others, and are looking for a rewarding career that has a lot of upward mobility, consider taking training to become a swine production technician. This program will set you on the path to becoming a swine production technician.

Gain an understanding of swine operations including regulations, health and safety, record keeping, and maintenance of barns and barn systems. Learn production practices related to stockmanship, pig health care, breeding, farrowing, nursery, and grow and finish. Professionalism skills will be built through communication and conflict resolution learning activities.

8 weeks per course | January & June start

Learners will build their network while building skills in managing production in barns, learning operational management and gaining practical knowledge in human resources management. All learning is supported through online modules and in-person sessions.

If you apply pesticides professionally in Manitoba, certification and licensing through Manitoba Agriculture is mandatory. Assiniboine College offers certification for the Pesticide Core as well as all licence categories required for professional pesticide applicators.

INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

1 week | start anytime



Integrated Pest Management (IPM) provides green space managers with the knowledge to achieve an acceptable level of pest control in a cost-effective and aseptically pleasing way while minimizing the use of pesticides. Members of the landscape and golf course industries and provincial government departments in Manitoba initiated the IPM certification program, to formally recognize industry qualifications and promote ongoing IPM education.

COMMERCIAL MANURE APPLICATOR

6 weeks | September, February & April start

 **Online**

The Commercial Manure Application program is designed to equip learners with the knowledge and skills needed to pass the licensing examinations required for Commercial Manure Applicator certification. This licensing process is administered by Manitoba Agriculture and Manitoba Environment, Climate and Parks under the Manure Amendment to the Pesticides and Fertilizers Control Act.

MANURE MANAGEMENT PLANNER

13 weeks | September, February & April start

 **Online**

Assiniboine's Manure Management Planner (MMP) program equips agrologists with the expertise to craft environmentally responsible manure application plans for crop production.

In the province of Manitoba, applying livestock manure to land is permitted exclusively for crop production as a fertilizer. Certain livestock operations are required to submit an annual Manure Management Plan (MMP) to Manitoba Environment and Climate Change. Livestock producers have the option to prepare this plan themselves or collaborate with a qualified Manure Management Planner.
