Will you remain in (never leave) Manitoba during the COVID-19 pandemic?

- Use only the "All Students" checklist under International Students/Accepted Students on the college website.
- □ Self-monitor health; see information about symptoms <u>here</u>. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, contact the public health office in your city/town to ask about testing.

Will you leave Manitoba at any time during the COVID-19 pandemic?

- You could be required by Canadian or Manitoba law to "quarantine" (also called "self-isolate") for 14 days. See <u>here</u> for the Canadian requirements and <u>here</u> for the Manitoba requirements.
- □ On the college website, use the checklist related to where you travel: to another province of Canada, or outside of Canada.
- □ *Also* use the "All Students" checklist under International Students/Accepted Students on the college website.
- □ Self-monitor health; see information about symptoms <u>here</u>. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, contact the public health office in your city/town to ask about testing.
- The college strongly suggests you do NOT leave Manitoba in the month before classes start. If you leave Manitoba, and then must quarantine for 14 days when you return, you will miss some on-campus classes. If you miss on-campus classes, you could lose marks and even fail courses. If there is an emergency, please contact your program Chair or Student Success Advisor before you leave to discuss your courses.
