Welcome to Assiniboine Community College!

As a *registered* student at Assiniboine there are things that you can do to prepare for a great Assiniboine experience. Please read the steps below to get college ready and experience campus life to its fullest.

Get College Ready

1. KNOW WHEN YOUR FIRST DAY OF CLASS IS

2. LOG INTO MYACC

As a *registered* student, you received a letter from the Registrar's Office providing important information about your registration, fees and payment options, student orientation (Xplore ACC), login information to MyACC, your Assiniboine network account, college email, parking etc. *Note: If you have not received this letter, you may not be registered and may not have access to MyACC. For questions related to your registration, contact the Registrar's Office (see Contact Information on pg 9).*

MyACC allows you to view your <u>class schedule</u>, financial account, current and past grades, evaluate your progress in your program, your profile (name, address etc.), <u>make on-line payments</u>, set up a payment plan (eligible programs only), register for continuing studies courses, change your address, view tax information, request transcripts etc. . *Note: Class schedules may be modified up to and including the first day of classes, please check your schedule regularly for updates.*

You can access MyACC at <u>myacc.assiniboine.net</u>. It is important that you check it regularly to ensure you are on track to graduate.

4. GET YOUR BOOKS & ASSINIBOINE SWAG

Textbooks, supplies, Assiniboine clothing and uniforms can be purchased at the Victoria Avenue East Campus Store, which is open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Friday or online at <u>assiniboineshop.ca</u>. Note: Books and supplies are identified by course, not by program, it is important that you bring your schedule into the campus store when purchasing your books and supplies.

5. APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES

7. APPLY FOR TRANSFER CREDIT

If you have taken courses at other accredited educational institutes that are the same, or very similar to courses offered at Assiniboine, you can apply for a transfer of credit. If you think this may apply to you, please read policy <u>A07 Credit for Previous Education</u> and submit the form attached to the policy, along with the course outlines from your prior institution, as early as possible to the Registrar's Office.

8. APPLY FOR PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT RECOGNITION

Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) provides the opportunity to obtain credit for college level knowledge and skills gained outside of the classroom. If you have acquired learning from formal education, work, and/or volunteer experience, personal study and other life activities you may consider applying for PLAR. To learn more, please read policy <u>A06 Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition</u>. Courses available for PLAR are identified with the symbol P in the current <u>academic calendar</u>.

9. PURCHASE PARKING

Student parking is available at each campus. Please refer to www.assiniboine.net/parking for the list of options and/or pricing for your campus location.

For students studying at campuses in Brandon, a free transit bus pass (UPASS) is included in your student fees. This pass is available at the Students' Association office.

10. ATTEND XPLORE ACC

Kick-off your time at college on the right foot and let us help you make a successful transition to college life. Xplore ACC, a mandatory program-specific orientation that brings together all your 'must have' and 'must know' details before the first day of classes.

If you're driven to make a lasting difference in people's lives, Assiniboine's 24-week Comprehensive Health Care Aide (CHCA) program prepares you for a challenging and fulfilling career in health care. If you have compassion and respect for people of all ages and cultures, then being a health care aide will be a rewarding choice.

Typical tasks in this field include dressing or assisting with hygienic needs, serving meals and feeding clients, lifting, moving, or assisting patients in walking, and observing and reporting patient conditions.

Through your course work and clinical practicum experiences, you will learn new things about yourself. You will be surprised to discover many other skills you possess, and you will gain the confidence to work in front of a group and develop your creative flair.

- $\sqrt{}$ Provides direct work with people of all ages
- $\sqrt{}$ Presents an opportunity to positively affect the lives of clients
- $\sqrt{}$ Is part of a growing field

- √ Broadens your awareness of changing health care trends
- $\sqrt{}$ You can work with children, adults, seniors, and clients with mental health concerns
