**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN NORTHERN ALBERTA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY
AND
ASSINIBOINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

This Articulation Agreement, dated November 27, 2023, is established to provide for the students of Assiniboine Community College in the Land and Water Management diploma the opportunity of admission to the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology (herein after referred to as “NAIT”) in the Bachelor of Technology program.

WHEREAS

1. NAIT is a Canadian post-secondary institution with a main campus located in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.
2. Assiniboine Community College is a Canadian post-secondary institution with a main campus located in Brandon, Manitoba, Canada.

OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT

1. To provide successful graduates from Land and Water Management who satisfy criteria identified by NAIT and described in this Agreement, the opportunity to obtain admission into the Bachelor of Technology, dependent upon space availability.
2. To attract qualified students from Assiniboine Community College to NAIT.
3. To provide specific program and course information to all graduates who wish to pursue their studies at NAIT.

TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

1. Both parties agree to promote each other’s institutional opportunities to prospective qualified students.
2. Both parties agree that the use of the other’s name and/or logo in any promotional materials will adhere to such guidelines regarding that institution’s brand identity as that institution may advise from time to time.

3. Students seeking admission under this Agreement must have successfully completed their Land and Water Management at Assiniboine Community College and must satisfy the posted entrance requirements to be considered for NAIT's Bachelor of Technology.
4. Applicants receiving an offer of admission to NAIT will also be granted advanced credit as outlined in Schedule "A" of this Agreement.
5. English is the primary language of instruction at NAIT. It is essential that all students have an adequate knowledge in the areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking in the English language to be successful. Applicants whose first language is not English must provide documentation to fulfil NAIT's English language proficiency requirements, which may be found at: www.nait.ca
6. Any notice or communication authorized or permitted with respect to this Agreement shall be effectively given in writing by personal delivery or by registered mail, postage prepaid, or by facsimile or email transmission as follows:

or at such other address as may be given by such party to the other party in writing from time to time. All such notices shall be deemed to have been received when personally delivered or upon successful fax or email transmission, or, if mailed, five (5) business days following deposit thereof in the mail, provided that in the event of threatened or actual postal disruption, all notices shall be either personally delivered or transmitted by fax or email.

7. This Agreement shall be in place for a period of five (5) years commencing January 1, 2024. Each party will provide the other party with at least sixty (60) days written notice of any substantial changes planned to admission standards, graduation requirement, curriculum or course offerings, or any planned changes to the length in weeks, hours of instruction or overall duration of each program.


8. This Agreement does not impose any financial liability on either of the signatory parties.
9. Termination of this Agreement shall only be undertaken by either party with written notice of one (1) calendar year and shall include appropriate processes for phasing out the transfer of credit arrangements described herein, in order that students who have entered the approved program(s) of Assiniboine Community College will not be penalized.


