

ARTICULATION/TRANSFER AGREEMENT

An Articulation/Transfer Agreement is a formal agreement between two educational institutions that spells out the terms and conditions for recognizing the learning that is done at one institution and applying that prior learning in the form of transfer credit at the other institution. These will typically be set with Assiniboine Community College (ACC) as the *Receiving* Institution when agreements are set up with Secondary Schools. ACC will be set as the *Sending* institution when students complete a credential at ACC first, then receive transfer credit at another post-secondary institution. This form (or another with the same content if developed by the partner institution) must be used for all ACC Articulation Agreements.

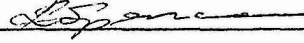

Receiving Institution – Brandon University

These Assiniboine Community College credits (Digital Art and Design or Web and Interactive Development) translate to a block of 60 Brandon University credit hours. Students must receive a minimum program GPA of 2.0 (minimum grade of C in each course) in order to be eligible for this block transfer. Please note that this block transfer will only be allowed for the BFA Digital Media and Design major. If students wish to change majors after admission to Brandon University, a course-by-course transfer evaluation will be made that may result in fewer transfer credits awarded for the new major.

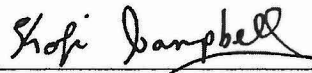
a. Digital Art and Design/Web and Interactive Development require Practicum for graduation.

10. When this document has been developed, it must be approved by the governing bodies at both institutions, if appropriate. Once approval has been gained, it will be signed by the Vice-presidents, Academic (or designate) at post-secondary institutions, and/or by the appropriate supervisor of education at secondary institutions.

11. These Assiniboine Community College credits will be eligible for a block transfer to the BU Digital Media and Design major for up to five years after date of graduation from ACC. Alternatively, if the student chooses to complete credits at BU first, then complete credits at ACC, they must begin their studies at ACC no later than 5 years after graduation from BU.
12. This agreement will remain in effect for 5 years from the date of signing. It can be withdrawn at any time by either party for any reason provided at least 6 months notice to the other institution. A student must have completed all required credits at one institution and have been accepted into the other institution before this articulation agreement expires to ensure they are able to complete this 2+2 agreement.
13. This agreement will be eligible for renewal upon expiry (see item 11) by providing written notice in the form of the Renewal Notice.
