



Admission Requirements (centre insert)

- Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Ontario admission requirements
- Changes to admission requirements:
 - CHCA: no longer requires criminal record and child/adult abuse checks at time of application
 - Practical Nursing: Preparation for Nursing replaced Math for Nurses
- ECE, ECPM, Education Assistant, Practical Nursing, Public Safety and Social Service Worker require documents/certifications (criminal record check, CPR, etc) as admission requirements
- The above programs have application checklists on the website to assist people in preparing their application



English Language Proficiency

- If English is **not** the applicant's first/primary language and they are **not** from a test exempt country, they must provide supporting documentation to show that they meet one of the options for providing proof of English language proficiency (test, program or meet one of the waivers)
- **Test options:** IELTS, TOEFL iBT, CanTEST, CAEL, PTE Academic, Duolingo
- Program options: Canadian Language Benchmarks (permanent residents only), ILAC, AEPUCE and more
- Waiver options: e.g. graduation from an English-speaking Manitoba high school with at least one Senior 4 Core English (not ESL) with a minimum of 70%
- Note: Practical Nursing has separate ELP requirements; visit assiniboine.net/pnelp for full details

Starting Your Assiniboine Journey (pg 41-43)

Apply online at assiniboine.net/apply

- Non-refundable \$95 application fee
- Official transcripts (high school and post-secondary)
 - Letter from school listing Grade 12 courses enrolled in, if currently attending high school or upgrading
- English language proficiency documentation, if required
- Photocopy of permanent resident card, if applicable
- Other documents depending on program requirements (e.g. criminal record check)

Note: Application checklists available for select programs with additional requirements (find on program pages on website)



Become a student (pg 43)

- Applications are complete when all documentation is submitted
- If admission requirements are met and there is space in the program, acceptance/conditional acceptance letter is sent by email
- A non-refundable tuition deposit is required
- Registration information is sent out two months prior to program start
 - At this point, students can now request a confirmation of enrolment letter through their MyACC account or online document request
- Orientation information will come following this
