Purpose:

To ensure training offered in partnership with other agencies/institutions/organizations meets standards acceptable to Assiniboine. This policy may be superseded when formal articulation agreements are in place.

Policy:

Assiniboine Community College responds to the community's demand for a range of training program delivery. This includes educational partnerships with other agencies, institutions and organizations. In such arrangements/partnerships, where certification by Assiniboine is a component, the following conditions/circumstances would apply:

- 1. The curriculum (including evaluation) to be taught will be Assiniboine curriculum, or Assiniboine approved curriculum. This determination is the responsibility of the Dean/Director.
- 2. The qualifications of program instructors must be acceptable to the school and be in keeping with the qualifications required of instructors within the school. The Dean/Director is responsible for making this determination.
- 3. Marking, student appeals of grades, student/instructor evaluation, and other relevant academic matters will conform to the academic policies and procedures of the academic school and Assiniboine Community College.
- 4. The students enrolled in such programs will be registered as Assiniboine students. These students may also be simultaneously registered at other institutions.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the Dean/Director to determine that the necessary facilities and resources required for the successful delivery of the program are provided.

Partnership arrangements	will be	collaborative	and	consultative	and	may	include	monitoring	visits,	and	student
and instructor orientations.
