A Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA) designation is required, and previous teaching or training experience will be considered a strong asset.

- ▶ Explore creative and engaging strategies to enhance comprehension and ensure that all students are effectively reached and supported in their learning.
- ▶ Modify and/or develop course objectives, outlines, curricula, and evaluation procedures and tools.
- ▶ Prepare and maintain all course-related records, including evaluations and attendance, and submit required information in a timely manner.
- ▶ Identify, prepare, and organize course materials and learning resources for effective course delivery.
- ▶ Foster and maintain a creative, engaging, positive, and respectful learning environment that encourages meaningful student learning.
- ▶ Manage the classroom environment and, if necessary, recommend actions to the supervisor regarding student behavior, including formal disciplinary measures.
