Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in the area of human services or related experience in working with children, families and the child welfare system;
 - Demonstrates interpersonal skills in developing effective working relationships with families, children and the service community;
 - Understands the issues facing families at risk and the impact of trauma;
 - Demonstrates a strong working knowledge of parenting strategies, including with children with high needs, life skills and other related training with the ability to teach this knowledge;
 - Knowledge of the importance of attachment for children and maintaining their connections to family and community;
 - Supports Indigenous values; has knowledge of Indigenous cultures and community issues;
 - Demonstrates skill in problem-solving, particularly during high stress situations;
 - Possesses a strong working knowledge of community resources;
 - Communicates effectively in verbal and written form, including strong skills in documentation; the ability to organize a busy schedule, follow through on all tasks as assigned and meet deadlines;
