- Delivered face-to-face on weekends, right here at Assiniboine Community College in Brandon
- Acclaimed faculty from all across Canada
- Can be completed in 24-26 months
- Courses scheduled 16 weekends per year (avoiding statutory holiday weekends)

The MBA in Community Economic Development appeals to people who want to make a difference in their organizations and communities, especially those working in community organizations, the public sector, social enterprises and entrepreneurial businesses.

MBA program costs:

For the 2019-20 academic year, program costs include an application fee of \$88, and a one-time program fee of \$440. Tuition is paid on a course by course basis at a rate of \$2,219 per course, for a total tuition of \$35,504 if all 16 MBA courses are required (all applicant transcripts are evaluated for Transfer Credits at time of application, potentially reducing courses required and tuition cost). The total program cost is approximately \$36,000.
