- Coordinate equipment utilization and performance with various operation groups
- Control and analyze maintenance costs and/or repairs and provide expert recommendations
- Manage and report on operational performance of the fleet, such as lifecycle management, cost per mile, and major component costs
- Interpret system data and reports enabling consistency, improvement and the execution of preventative fleet maintenance.
- Provide data and reports to the Director of Maintenance
- Assist in the development of a capital equipment replacement budget
- Develop and maintain good relationships with vendors and leasing companies
- Coach and mentor technicians
- Lead, practice and oversee safety in all shops to ensure accident and incident free environment and a clean space
- Provide after-hours support
