Why should you choose a program in Applied Counselling Skills?

- Become proficient in basic counselling skills so you may help others with their personal growth and in building healthier communities.
- **2.** Learn about cross-cultural communication, family and youth issues, as well as trauma-informed practice within the bounds of a counselling environment.
- Develop the ethical and theoretical knowledge to work in health, education, government counselling agencies, corrections, with new immigrants, and within First Nations communities.
- 4. Plan for future education pathways! Two courses in the Applied Counselling Skills program are transferable into Assiniboine's Social Service Worker diploma program.

Part-time, On-Campus Learning

The next start date for this program is September 2020.

Completion of this program takes five semesters, with a break during the first summer term. Expected completion date (after the practicum placement) is November 2022.

Graduates may find employment as para-professionals and skilled assistants in counselling-related fields. Past graduates of this program have found employment in the following roles: youth worker, intake worker, case worker, counsellor (educational, crisis, domestic violence), facilitators, education assistants, etc.

- A complete Manitoba Grade 12 or equivalent
- English 40G/40S or equivalent with a minimum mark of 60%.
- This is a competitive entry program (complete Supplemental Application form required)
- Criminal Record Check
- Adult Abuse Registry Check
- Child Abuse Registry Check
