

Label and Page Resources in Moodle

(Setting up and Editing Label and Page Resources on a Moodle course page)

The Label and Page resources are used to convey information and links to students. Videos can be embedded into either resource.

What's the difference between these resources?

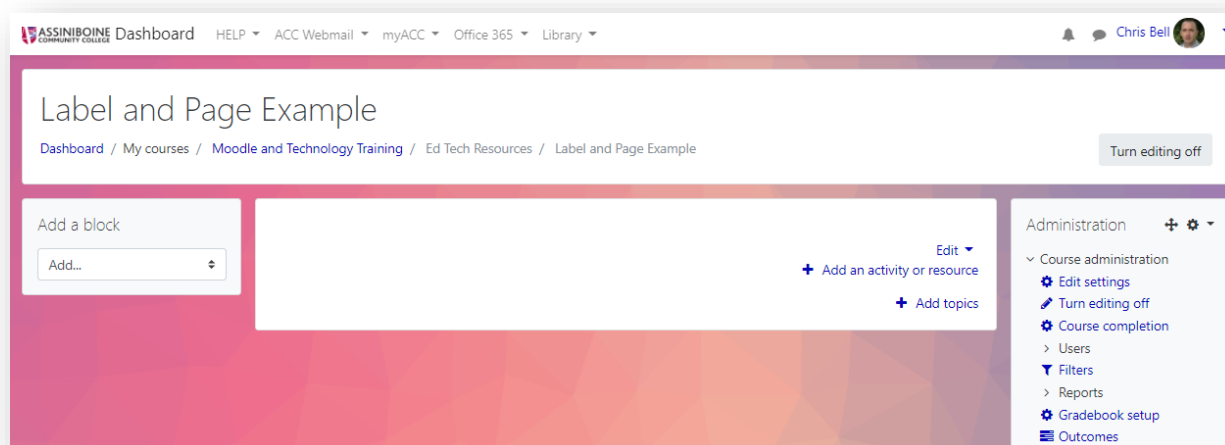
A *Label* appears **directly** on the course page.

A *Page* appears as a **selectable link** on the main course page. Selecting the link brings the user to a separate page that contains the information/links/videos.

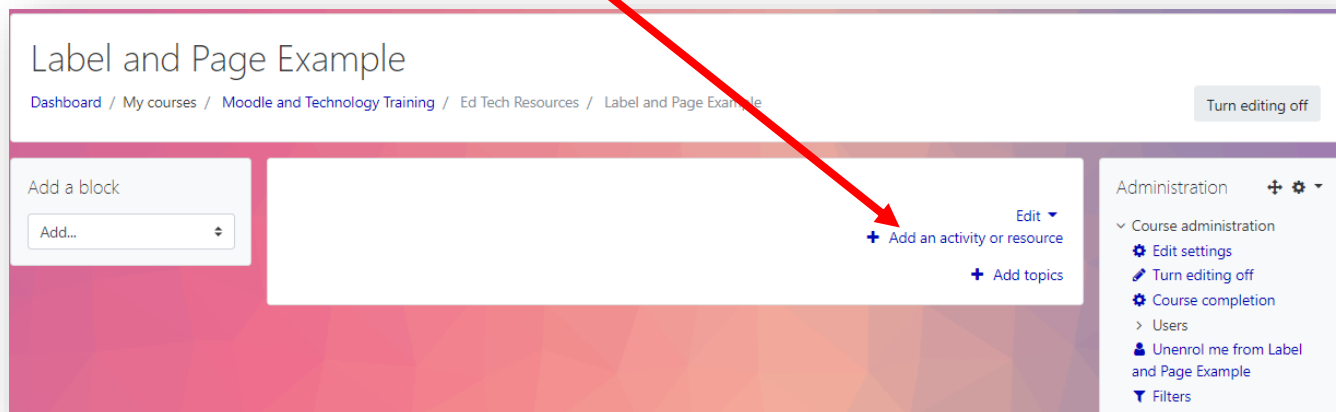
Workflow

1. Have any pictures or GIFs you want to include on the Label or Page saved on your computer.
2. Have any embed links copied to a convenient location (like a word document)
3. Create the resource
4. Add content to the resource
5. Format text as desired
6. View the resource in a 'student' role to see it exactly as the students will see it

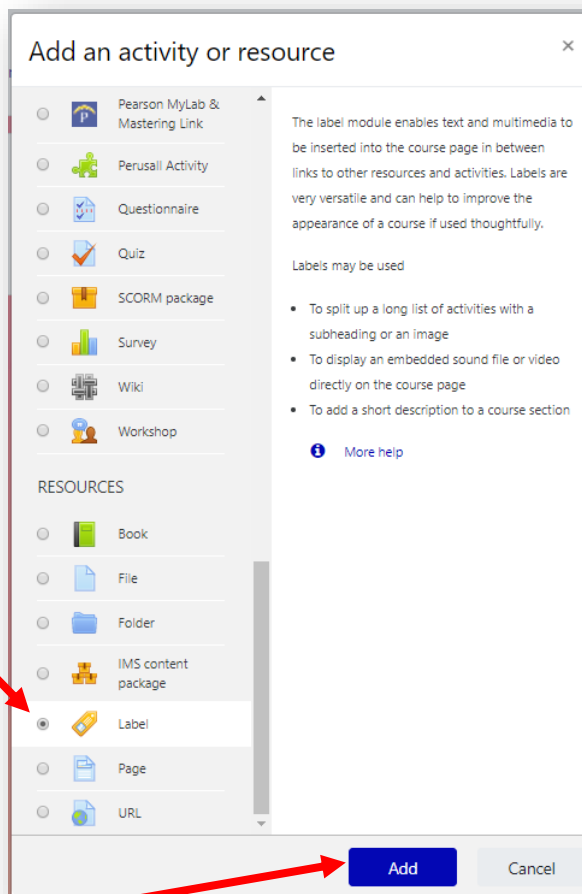
Create a Label (starting with a blank page)



Step 1: After assembling all the pictures, videos links, and text that is going to appear on the label, select the link “+ Add an activity or resource”



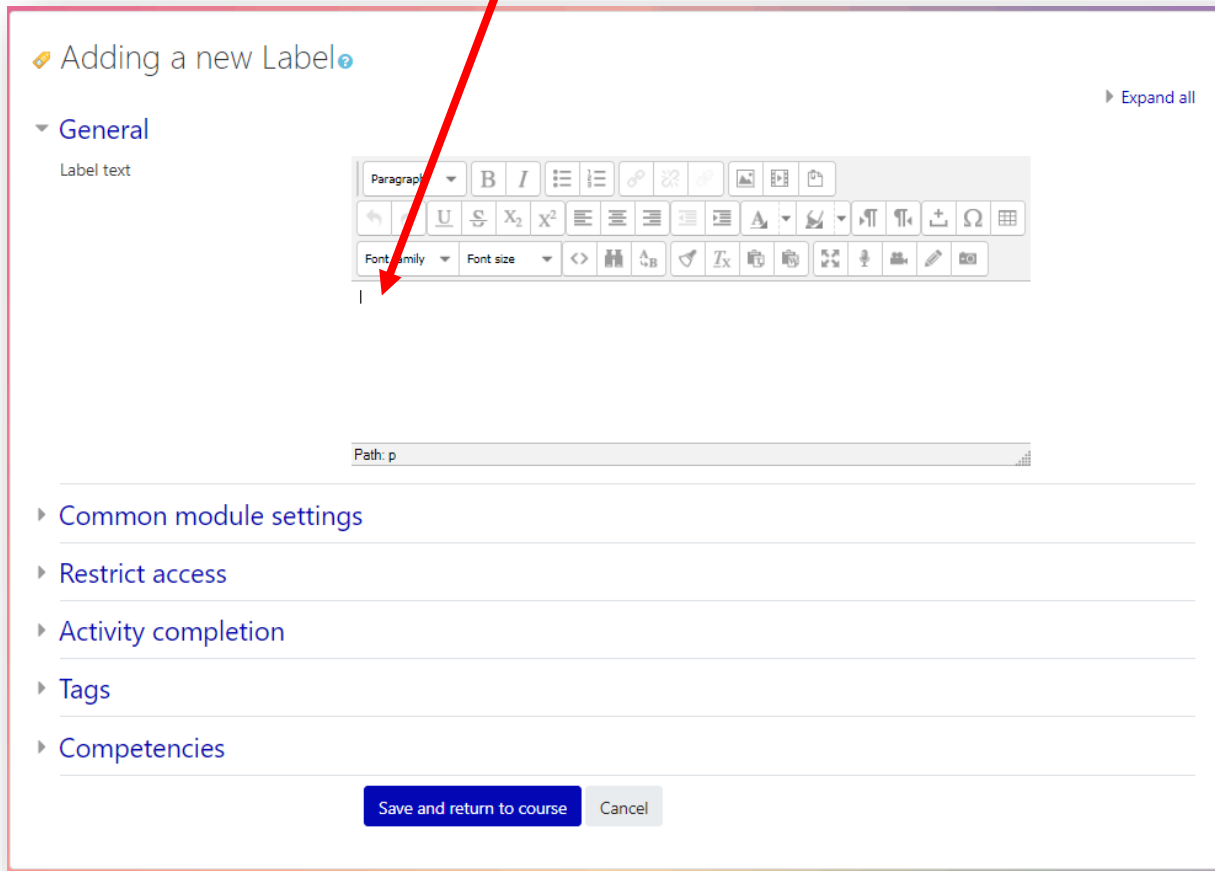
Step 2: Beside the resource “Label”, select the radio button



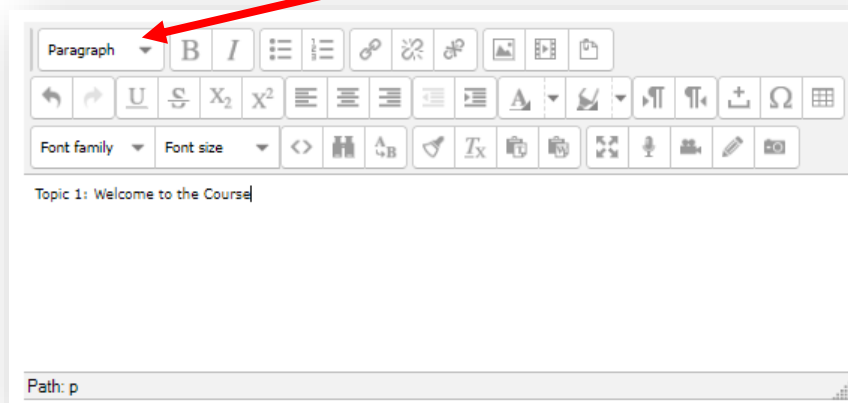
Step 3: Select the button “Add”

Step 4: Enter your media into the WYSIWYG editor. For this example, I will add:

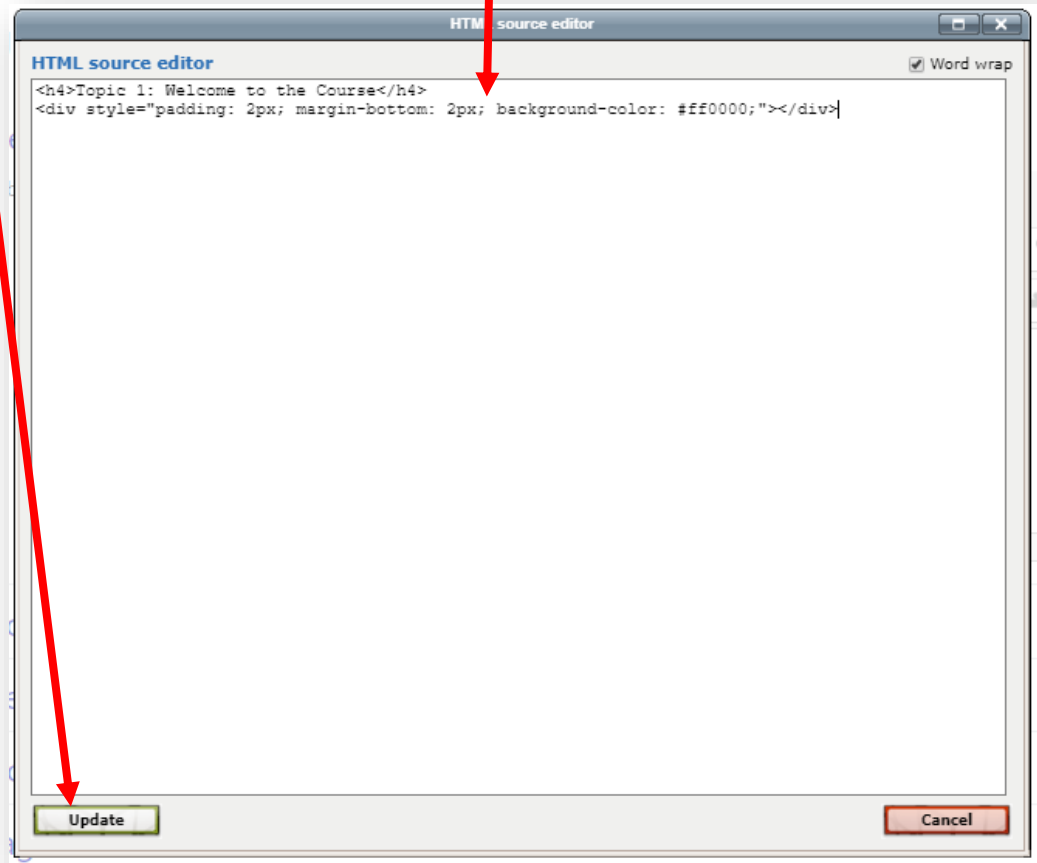
- a) some text
- b) a line using the HTML editor
- c) a picture
- d) an embedded video



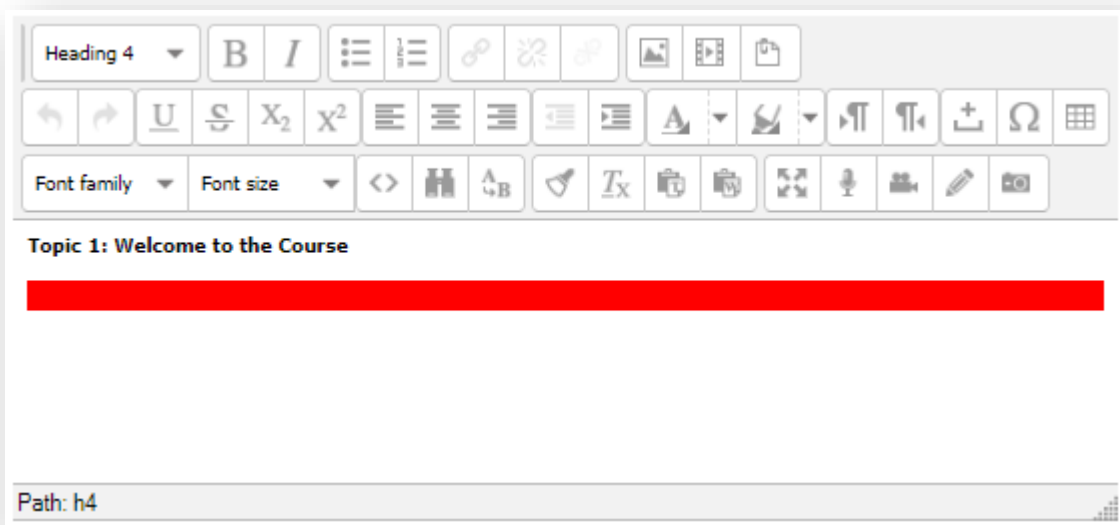
Step 4a TEXT 1: Text is entered directly into the WYSIWYG editing box. When first typing into the box, the text is created as “Paragraph” text by default.



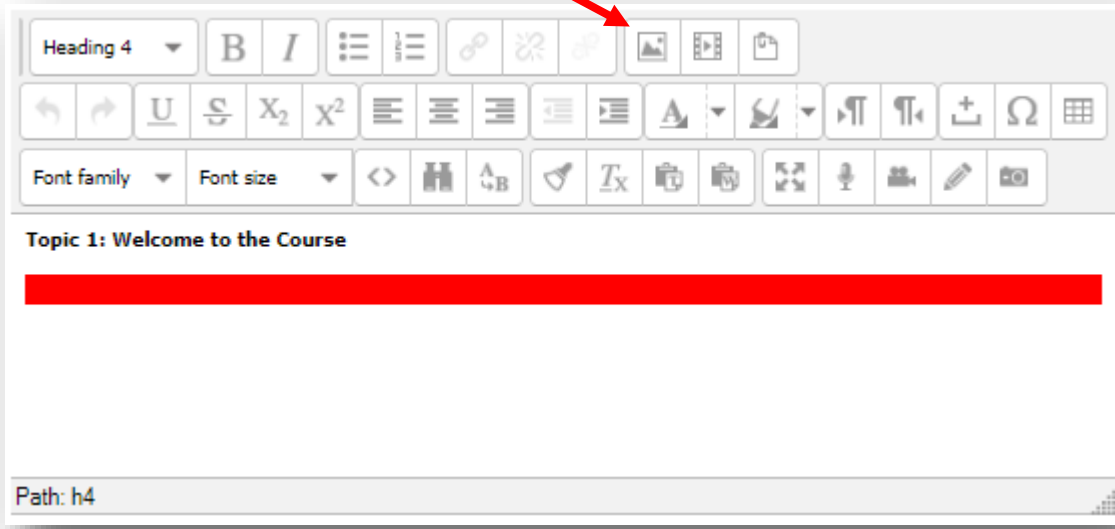
Step 4b HTML editor 2: Replace the `<p></p>` with the code shown in the previous step. Then select the button “Update”



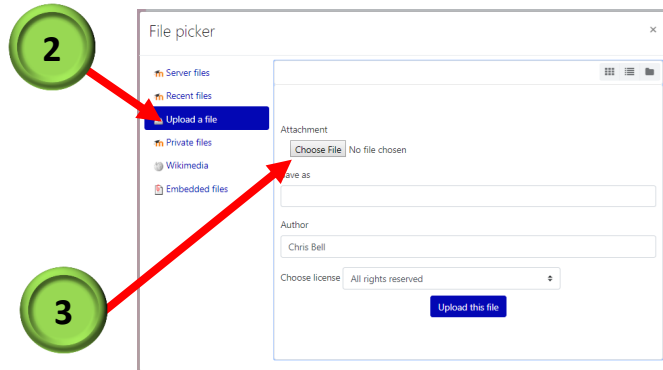
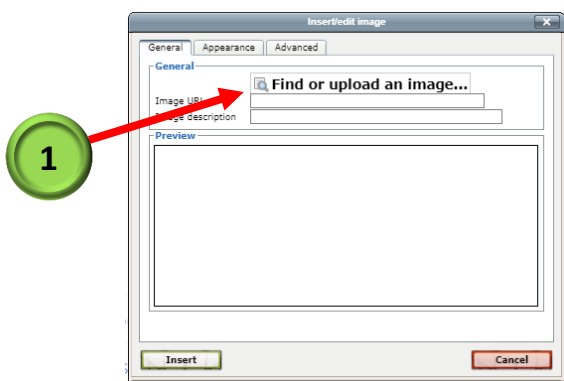
The line doesn't look so thin right now – but it will on the course page.



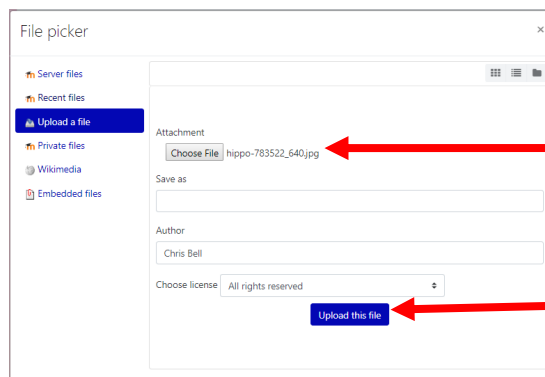
Step 4c PICTURE: Next I want to add a picture below the red line. On the WYSIWYG editor, select the button “Insert/edit image”



Use the File Picker to locate the image on your computer.

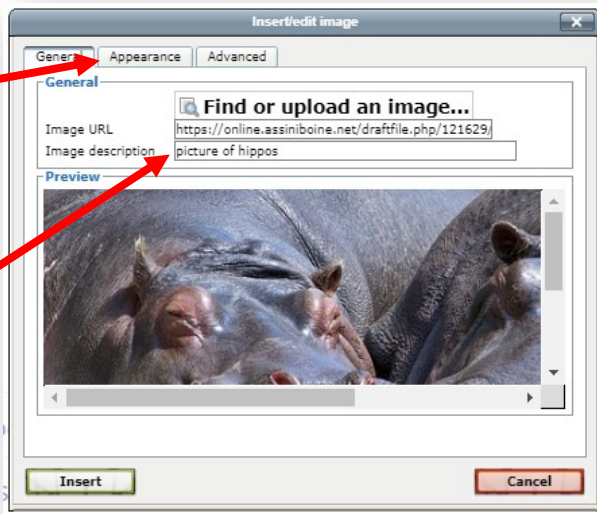

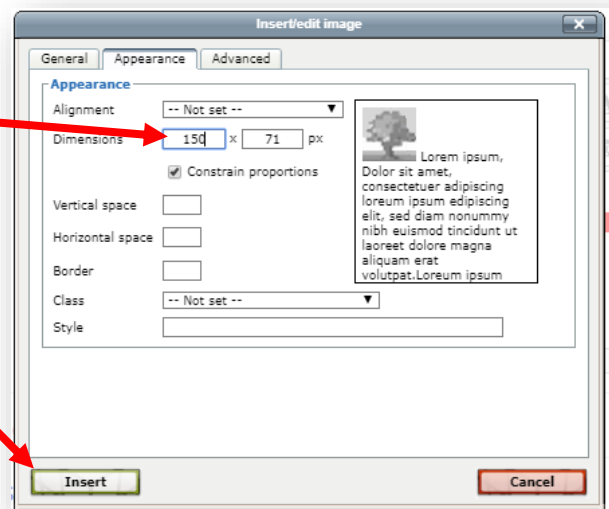

To change the display size of the picture on the Label, select the tab "Appearance"

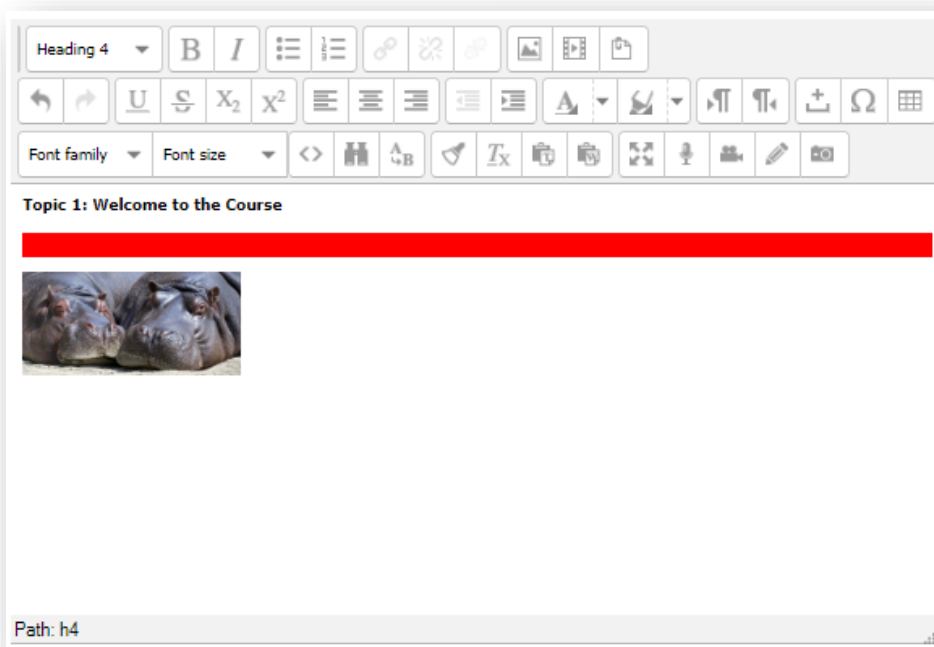


Don't forget to add an "Image description" for those who are using screen readers

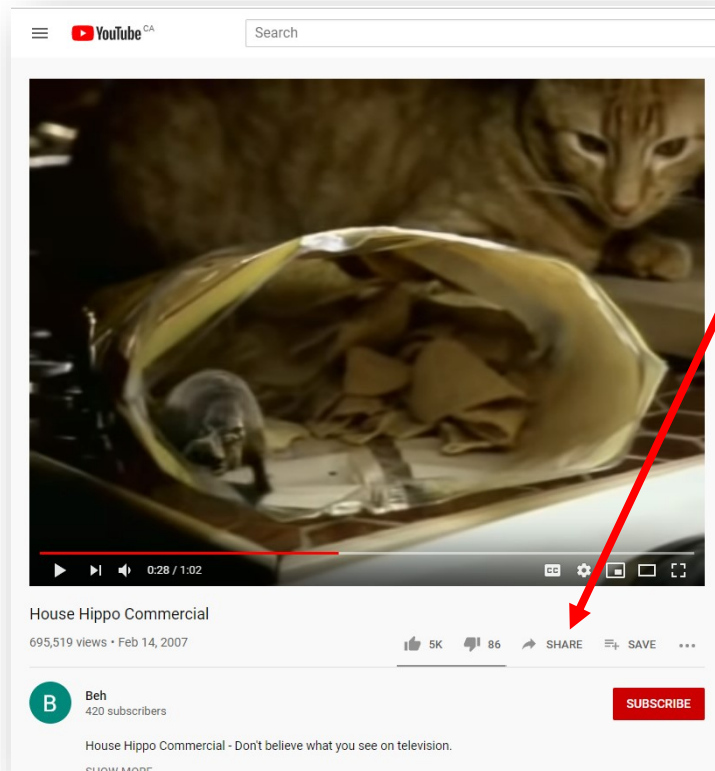
To change the display size of the image, change this number



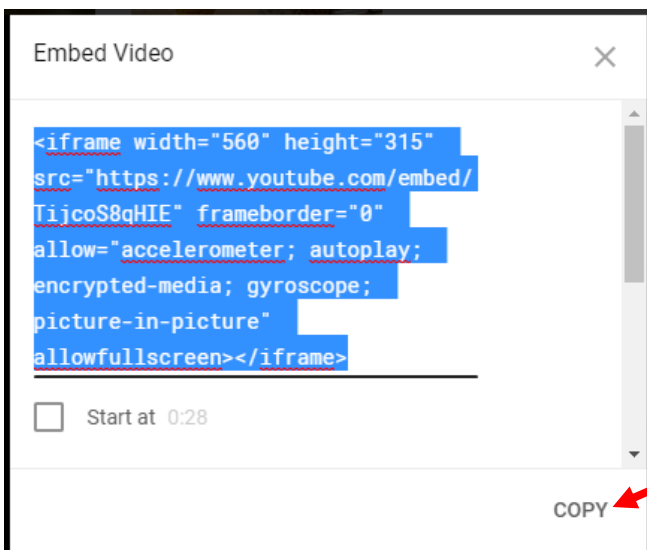
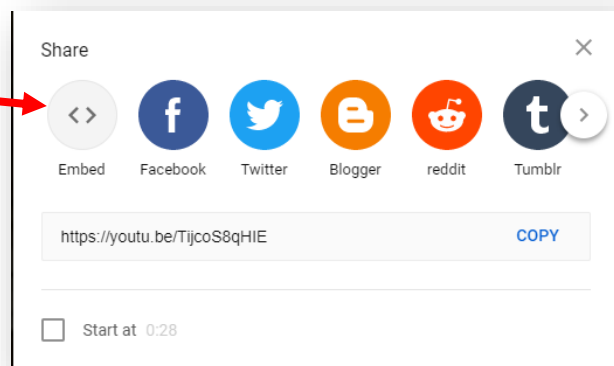
The select the button "Insert"



Step 4d VIDEO 1: Next I want to embed a video from YouTube. The first step is to get the embed code. Navigate to the video in YouTube. At the bottom of the video, select the button "SHARE"

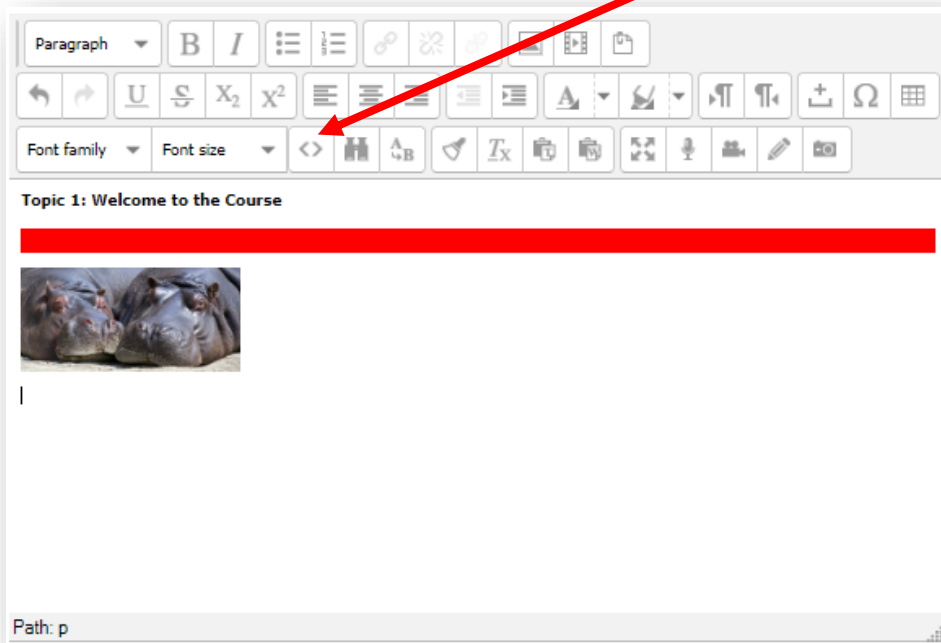


Select the embed code button "<>"

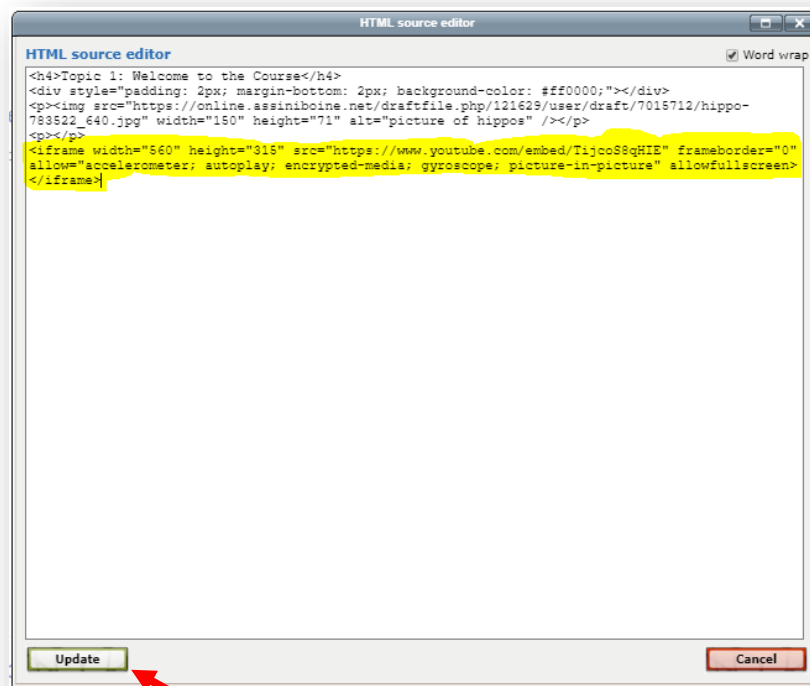


Select the word COPY

Step 4d VIDEO 2: To enter HTML embed code, first select the button “<>”

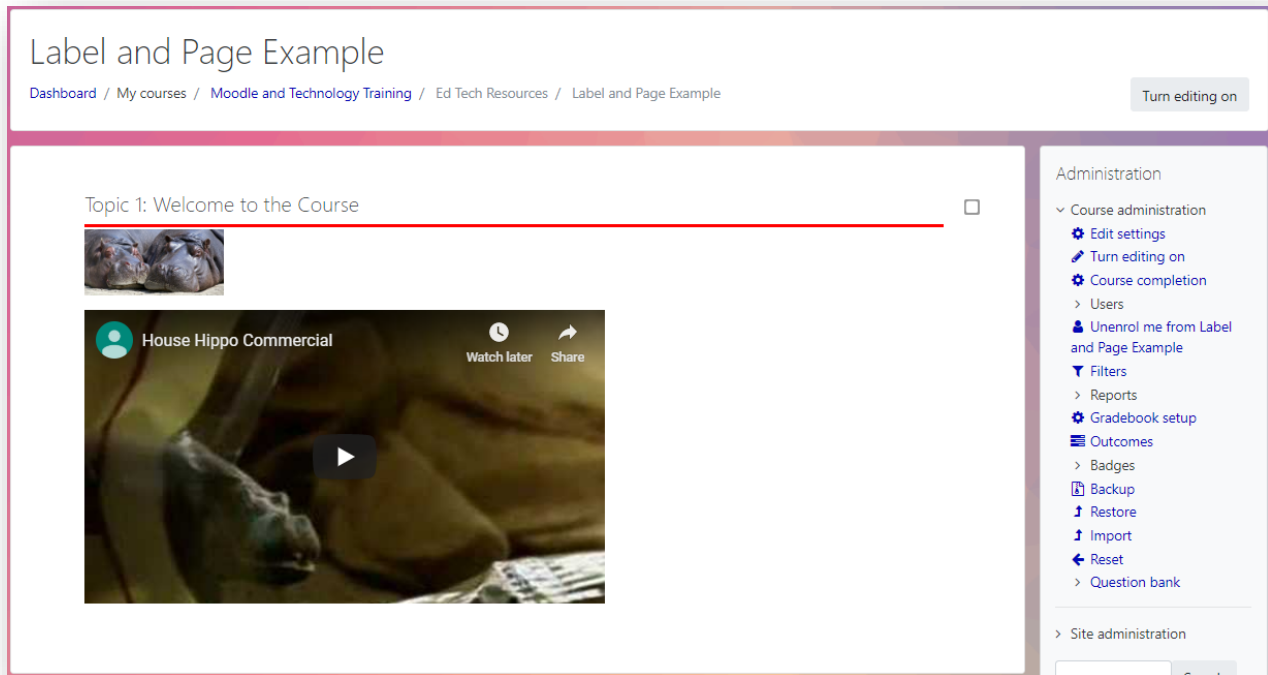
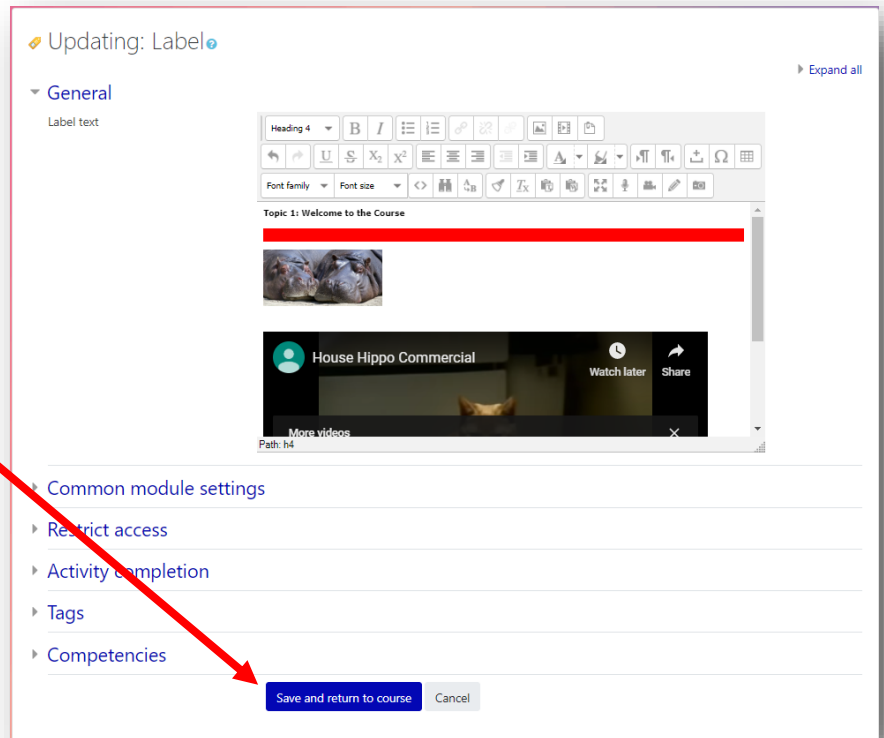


Step 4d VIDEO 3: Paste (ctrl-v) the embed code – it is highlighted yellow in this example.



Step 4d VIDEO 4: Select the button “Update”

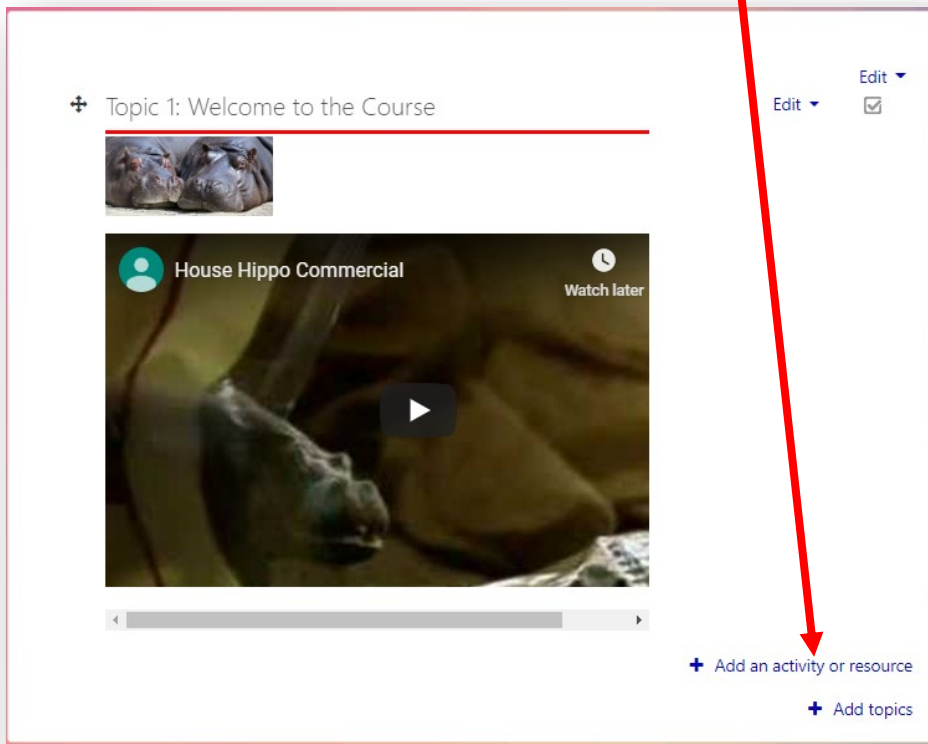
Step 5: Once all the media that you want on the Label has been added, select the button “Save and return to course”



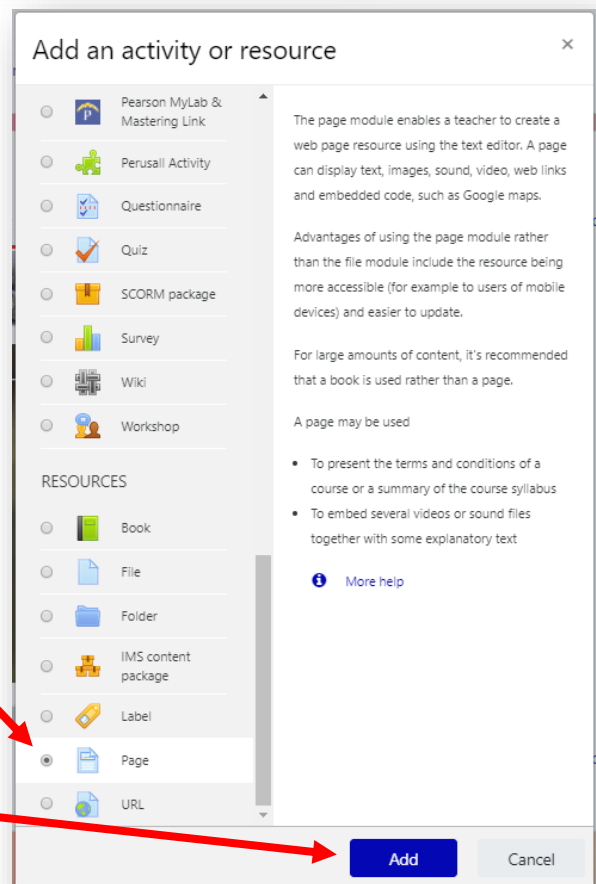
This is what the course page looks like now. If this course had many topics, you can imagine how congested the course page would become. We can remedy this by using a Page resource.

Create a Page (that contains the picture and the video)

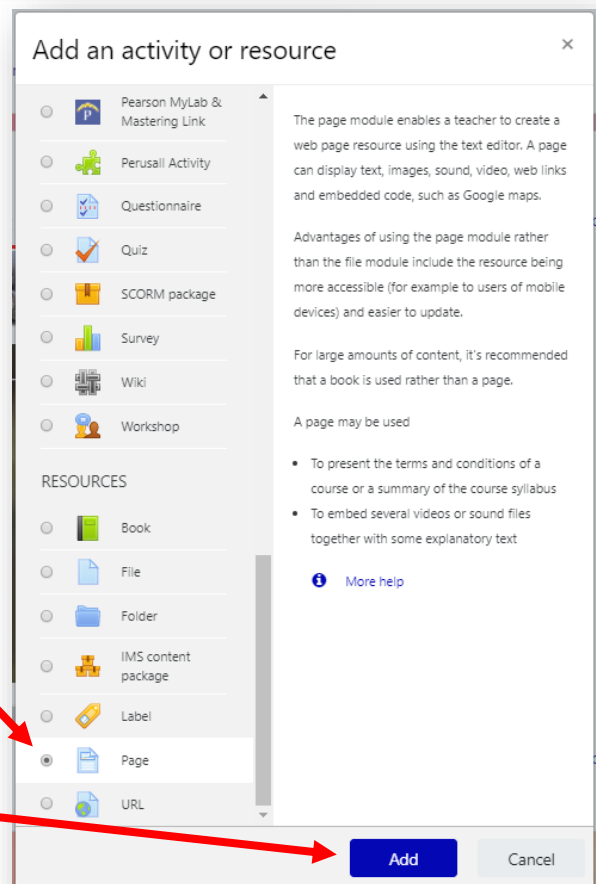
Step 1: After turning editing on, select the link “+ Add an activity or resource”



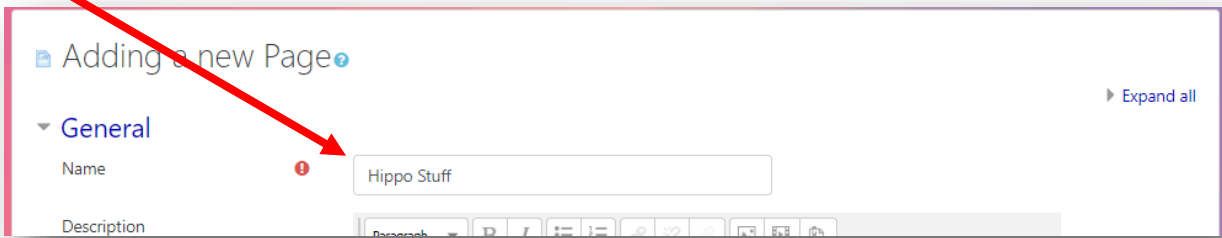
Step 2: Beside the resource “Label”, select the radio button



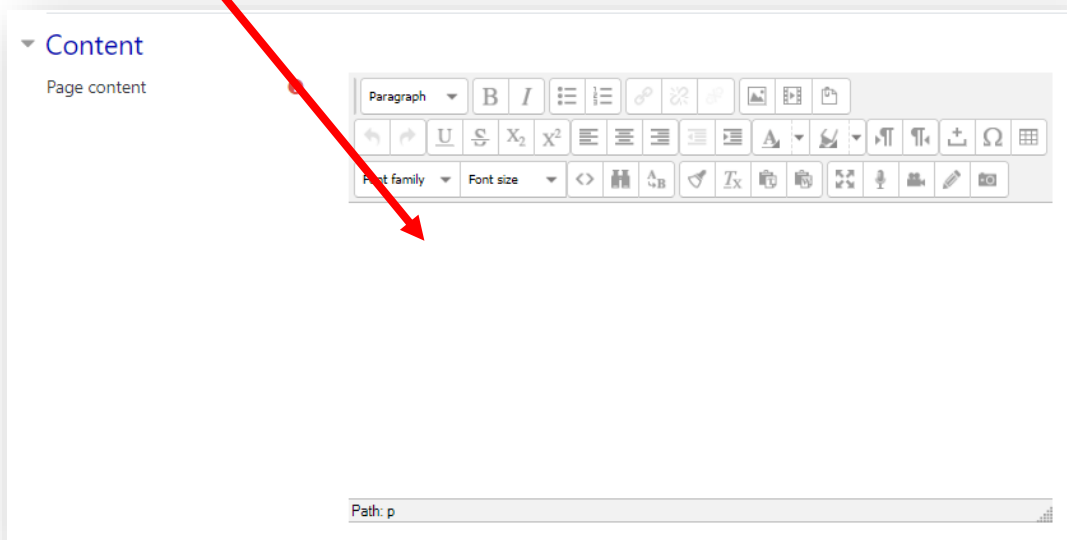
Step 3: Select the button “Add”



Step 4: Name the Page. This is the name that will appear on the main course page.

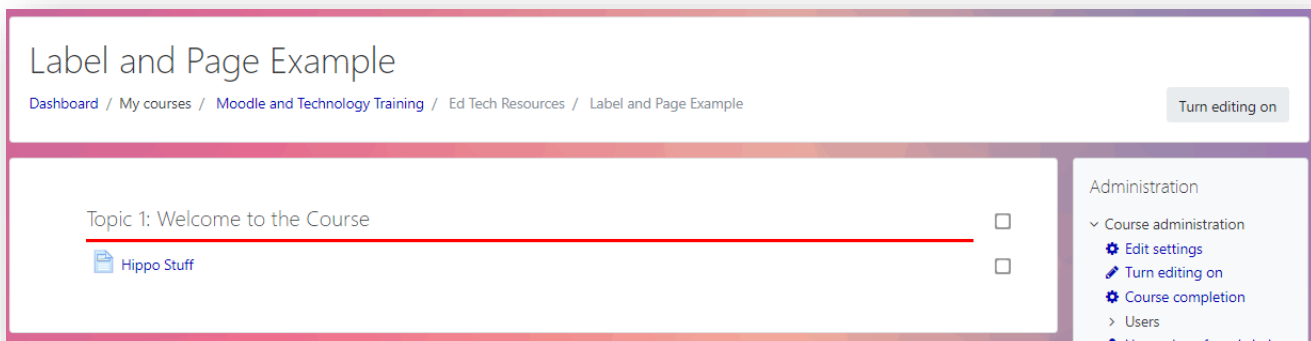


Step 5: Enter the media into the WYSIWYG editor content box in the same way as you do for the Label resource.




I deleted the picture and the video from the Label on the main course page, and added the media to the Page resource. This is how the main course page looks now. A little less congested for sure.

To see the media in this example, the student would click on the link "Hippo Stuff"




Here is the page that the student is taken to if they click on the page resource.
