CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will find employment in acute and extended care hospitals, personal care homes, private care facilities, mental health settings and home care.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A complete Manitoba Grade 12 or equivalent
- Current criminal record check
- Current child abuse registry check
- Current adult abuse registry check
- Proof of current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation Health Care Provider (CPR-HCP)

Applicants who are accepted into the program will also be required to provide proof of up-to-date immunization prior to the start of practicum rotations.

English is the language of instruction at Assiniboine. All applicants educated outside of Canada or in a country not on the test exempt list are expected to meet the English language proficiency requirement. See **assiniboine.net/elp** for more information.

CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK/ ABUSE REGISTRY CHECKS

Many agencies where students are placed for practicum experience require students to disclose convictions for any offenses. In some instances, applicants with a criminal record or listed on the Child Abuse Registry and/or Adult Abuse Registry may be unable to complete the program. If you fall into one of these categories, please contact the School of Health & Human Services prior to applying.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate with a Comprehensive Health Care Aide certificate, students must successfully complete 27 academic credits and 6 practical credits.

The minimum passing grade for each course is indicated on the course outline.
