Once the simulation stage is over, you will get practical experience in the seat of actual equipment. Train on excavators, wheeled loaders, bulldozers and backhoe loaders—you'll have instructors in the pit with you every step of the way, ensuring you can put what you've learned into practice.

4 Building your prospects

This program is for students who would like to enter the in-demand field of Heavy Equipment Operating used in the construction and maintenance of roads, bridges, airports, gas and oil pipelines, buildings and other structures. Operators are well-compensated and jobs are in demand, both in Manitoba and across Canada.



Admission Requirements

- A minimum of Grade 10 or equivalent
- Valid Class 5 driver's license

Graduation Requirements

To receive a Heavy Equipment Operator certificate of achievement, students must successfully complete 280 academic hours and 120 practicum hours.

Program Fees

The tuition cost for this program is **\$9,995**. A non-refundable tuition deposit of **\$2,000** must be paid to hold your seat; upon acceptance into the program, this amount will be deducted from the total tuition cost.
