CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will find employment in acute and extended care hospitals, personal care homes, private care facilities, mental health settings and home care.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A complete Manitoba Grade 12 or equivalent
- Current criminal record check
- Current child abuse registry check
- Current adult abuse registry check
- Proof of current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation Health Care Provider (CPR-HCP)

Applicants who are accepted into the program will also be required to provide proof of up-to-date immunization prior to the start of practicum rotations.

English is the language of instruction at Assiniboine. All applicants educated outside of Canada or in a country not on the test exempt list are expected to meet the English language proficiency requirement. See **assiniboine.net/elp** for more information.

TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

Programs at Assiniboine have certain technology requirements. Students require access to computer devices at home and may be required to bring these on campus when instructed. Refer to **assiniboine.net/tech** for more detailed information about the requirements for this program.

CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK/ ABUSE REGISTRY CHECKS

Many agencies where students are placed for practicum experience require students to disclose convictions for any offenses. In some instances, applicants with a criminal record or listed on the Child Abuse Registry and/or Adult Abuse Registry may be unable to complete the program. If you fall into one of these categories, please contact the School of Nursing prior to applying.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate with a Comprehensive Health Care Aide certificate, students must successfully complete 27 academic credits and 6 practical credits.

The minimum passing grade for each course is indicated on the course outline.
