#### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

# **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- » A complete Manitoba Grade 12 or equivalent
- » Current criminal record check
- » Current child abuse registry check
- » Proof of current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) Level C

English is the language of instruction at Assiniboine. All applicants educated outside of Canada or in a country not on the test exempt list are expected to meet the English language proficiency requirement. See **assiniboine.net/elp** for more information.

## TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

Programs at Assiniboine have certain technology requirements. Students require access to computer devices at home and may be required to bring these on campus when instructed. Refer to **assiniboine.net/tech** for more detailed information about the requirements for this program.

# CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK/ ABUSE REGISTRY CHECKS

Many agencies where students are placed for practicum experience require students to disclose convictions for any offenses. In some instances, applicants with a criminal record or listed on the Child Abuse Registry may be unable to complete the program. If you fall into one of these categories, please contact the School of Health & Human Services prior to applying.

# **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

To graduate with an Education Assistant certificate, students must successfully complete 30 academic credits and 2 practical credits.

The minimum passing grade for each course is indicated on the course outline.

#### CONNECTIONS

Graduates may be eligible to receive advanced standing in several other programs, including Early Childhood Education at Assiniboine.

Assiniboine has a number of agreements with other colleges, universities and professional organizations, making it possible for students to apply credit taken at Assiniboine to programs at other institutions.
