The trade requires tradespeople to work in many different types of weather conditions. Although the College experience will take place largely in classrooms and shops, it may also take place in the College compound where the construction of buildings may take place or work on outside structures. Students should be prepared to equip themselves accordingly to accommodate these conditions. Advice on necessary tool purchases can be obtained from the instructor of the program.
