

Construction Electrician Tool List 2022-23

All costs are approximate and are subject to change.

The trade requires tradespeople to work in many different types of weather conditions. Although the college experience will take place largely in classrooms and shops, it may also take place in the college compound where the construction of buildings may take place or work on outside structures. Students should be prepared to equip themselves accordingly to accommodate these conditions.

Required Supplies (Needed for first day of class) - \$265

- Safety Glasses (CSA Approved with Safety Cords) – clear lenses \$20
- Hearing Protection (as required in shops) \$15
- Classroom supplies (binders, paper, pens, pencils) \$50
- Sharp EL-531XT Calculator \$20
- Duo Mobile APP Download FREE
- OR YubiKey (see below) \$70.00
- **Must have access to a computer/laptop**, complete with a camera, microphone, and Microsoft Office.

- **Must have access to the Internet**

Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

Assiniboine Community College requires all students and staff to use an additional method to verify identity when accessing college systems, this is known as [multifactor authentication \(MFA\)](#). MFA adds an extra layer of security to protect you, your personal information and college systems from unauthorized access and phishing attacks.

In order to access any program on the College's network, including MyACC, you are required to:

1. Download the free DUO Mobile app on your own mobile device and follow the enrollment steps outlined in the video on the MFA webpage, visit assiniboine.net/mfa. *Note: You will only do this when you first attempt to access our college system. Do not delete the app after, you will need it for every time you login to Assiniboine services.*

2. Purchase a YubiKey, costs vary by type and are available at the Bookstore. It is important to know the type required for your device.
