

VALEDICTORIAN 2023



The Assiniboine Community College Students' Association (ACCSA) will be selecting Two Valedictorians this year to represent the graduating class of 2023. Two Valedictorians will be selected, one from each of the following student groups:

- The June 9th Graduation Ceremony for all graduates of Parkland campus that graduate July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.
- The June 16th Graduation Ceremony for graduates of all other campuses and of distance education and apprenticeship programs that graduate November 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

The Valedictorians selected will be required to prepare a speech that will be delivered at their respective graduation ceremony.

Valedictorian Eligibility

To be eligible, you must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Be a graduating student from a program offered for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- 2. Have a minimum G.P.A of 3.0
- 3. Have a strong history of student involvement at ACC and/or ACCSA
- 4. Complete the application form (pg. 2 and 3 of this document), as well as a 500-word essay
- 5. Your application must be nominated/endorsed by two ACC graduating students and two ACC faculty/staff members.

Selection Criteria

Applications will be selected based on the following:

- academic performance
- extra-curricular activities
- contribution to college life
- answers provided on this form

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will be composed of the ACCSA Executive Director (chair), an ACC staff member from the Graduation Committee, the ACC Associate Registrar, and two non-graduating students selected by the Students' Association Council.

Submission Deadline

The application deadline is **Friday April 21**st, **2023** by **4:00 pm**. Please send all completed forms and the essay (all in PDF Format) via email to paulk7121@assiniboine.net. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the ACC Students' Association for more information.
