- ▶ Lead organizational change using various leadership approaches by enacting ethical standards that reduce conflict in various situations that may occur in an early childhood setting.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Two-year Early Childhood Education diploma or current Early Childhood Education II (ECEII) from the Manitoba Child Care program.
- ▶ Minimum one-year Early Learning Centre experience as an ECE II verified in a letter from an Early Learning Centre Director or equivalent.
