Pre-season starts in the summer with league beginning in September and done by the end of October. The team typically practices two-four times a week with games on the weekends. The winner from the MCAC goes on to represent Manitoba at the Canadian Colleges Athletic Association national championships in early November. The team then shifts to indoor for the winter months (a lighter load in January & February) to play futsal.

- ► Coach communicate clearly, evaluate performance, practice and game planning, goal setting, provide tactical, technical and constructive feedback
- ► Recruit establish a network within the soccer community, continually recruiting players to the college to enrol in classes and participate in sport, ensuring a competitive team
- Administrative responding to e-mails, submitting information to the athletics manager (athlete of the week nomination, statistics, etc.)
