ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

CAREERS & CONNECTIONS

Students who successfully complete this course qualify as Manure Management Planner and must apply to Agrologists of Manitoba to be added to the Manure Management Planner Registry. The registry is a list of individuals qualified to prepare third party Manure Management Plans in accordance with the Livestock Manure and Mortalities Regulation. Agrologists Manitoba administers the public registry under agreement with Manitoba Environment and Climate Change that require anyone preparing MMPs on behalf of an operator to be listed on a third-party registry.

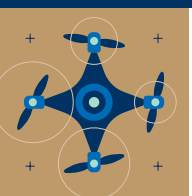
