Travel will be required to support classroom, simulation, clinical and field-based learning activities, community engagement initiatives, industry partnerships, and other program-related responsibilities. This position is primarily performed in person. Depending on operational requirements, some responsibilities may be completed remotely.

- ▶ Contribute to simulation-based education through the development and delivery of realistic learning scenarios, the effective use of simulation equipment, and the sharing of knowledge and best practices with colleagues across the program and college.
- ▶ Support student success through assessment, feedback, academic guidance, and mentorship.
- ▶ Collaborate with faculty, students, and community partners to support meaningful clinical and field practicum experiences that connect classroom learning with real-world paramedic practice.

- ▶ Valid driver's license in good standing.
- ▶ Ability to work confidently in a digital environment, including proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook), and a willingness to learn and adapt to emerging technologies (e.g., AI tools) and college-supported platforms.
- ▶ Excellent interpersonal and professional skills, including the ability to communicate clearly, collaborate effectively in diverse teams, adapt to change, and demonstrate sound judgment and problem-solving in a dynamic learning environment.
- ▶ A commitment to fostering student success, continuous improvement, and lifelong learning is essential.
