Graduate faster: earn your high school diploma and a health care aide certificate together. Complete Grade 12 Math and English, then start the integrated program utilizing dual credits—college courses that count for high school credit too. Graduate ready for a rewarding career in health care.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

CHCA graduates find employment in acute and extended care hospitals, personal care homes, private care facilities, mental health settings, and home care.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Meet the admission requirements for the Mature Student High School diploma program
- ▶ Prior to starting the Comprehensive Health Care Aide program applicants must provide:
 - ▶ Proof of current certification in Basic Life Support (BLS) or cardiopulmonary resuscitation, Health Care Provider level (CPR-HCP).

Students in this program must obtain the following prior to their clinical placements in the program:

- ▶ Current Canadian criminal record vulnerable sector check
- ▶ Current adult abuse registry check
- ▶ Current child abuse registry check
- ▶ Up to date immunization

English is the language of instruction at Assiniboine. All applicants educated outside of Canada or in a country not on the test exempt list are expected to meet the English language proficiency requirement. See assiniboine.net/elp for more information.

DUAL CREDITS

Dual credits are selected college courses taken at the high school level and count for both college credit and high school completion. Courses can be used for dual credit

provided the student attains the required percentage determined by the college. The use of dual credits in this program allows the completion of the high school diploma as well as the Comprehensive Health Care Aide certificate.

PROGRAM FEES (DOMESTIC ONLY)

High school courses are available at minimal cost, allowing students to earn their high school diploma without significant financial barrier. Students pay only the course fees, Students' Association fees and material costs. There is also no application fee for the Mature Student High School diploma.
