More opportunities for career advancement are available to people who have received a Grade 12 credential. Obtaining prerequisites for post-secondary school or upgrading current grades to meet admission requirements opens new windows of opportunity for training and employment in new careers.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ A complete Manitoba grade 12 or equivalent
- ▶ Minimum of 18 years of age

English is the language of instruction at Assiniboine. All applicants educated outside of Canada or in a country not on the test exempt list are expected to meet the English language proficiency requirement. See assiniboine.net/elp for more information.

PROGRAM FEES (DOMESTIC ONLY)

High school courses are available at minimal cost, allowing students to earn their high school diploma without significant financial barrier. Students pay only the course fees, Students' Association fees and material costs. There is also no application fee for the Mature Student High School diploma.
