Get College Ready

1. KNOW WHEN YOUR FIRST DAY OF CLASS IS

2. LOG INTO MYACC

As a *registered* student, you received a letter from the Registrar's Office providing important information about your registration, fees and payment options, student orientation (Xplore ACC), login information to MyACC, your Assiniboine network account, college email, parking etc. *Note: If you have not received this letter, you may not be registered and may not have access to MyACC. For questions related to your registration, contact Parkland Campus (see Contact Information on pg 9).*

MyACC allows you to view your <u>class schedule</u>, financial account, current and past grades, evaluate your progress in your program, your profile (name, address etc.), <u>make on-line payments</u>, set up a payment plan (eligible programs only), register for continuing studies courses, change your address, view tax information, request transcripts etc. *Note: Class schedules may be modified up to and including the first day of classes, please check your schedule regularly for updates.*

You can access MyACC at <u>myacc.assiniboine.net</u>. It is important that you check it regularly to ensure you are on track to graduate.

Open the door to a world of exciting careers by upgrading your skills or earning your Mature Student High School Diploma. We have small class sizes and focused one-on-one instructor attention, with a schedule that fits your needs in either our day or evening program.

Graduation Requirements

To graduate with a Mature Student High School Diploma students must be 19 years of age upon graduation, and earn a total of eight (8) credits; distributed as follows:

Compulsory Requirement:

English 12 – one credit at Grade 12 (Senior 4) level; Mathematics 12 – one credit at Grade 12 (Senior 4) level

Elective Requirement:

Two credits in any subject at Grade 12 (Senior 4) level;
Four credits in any subject from Grade 9 (Senior 1) through Grade 12 (Senior 4)
