



ARTICULATION/TRANSFER AGREEMENT

An Articulation/Transfer Agreement is a formal agreement between two educational institutions that spells out the terms and conditions for recognizing the learning that is done at one institution and applying that prior learning in the form of transfer credit at the other institution. These will typically be set with Assiniboine Community College (ACC) as the *Receiving* Institution when agreements are set up with Secondary Schools. ACC will be set as the *Sending* institution when students complete a credential at ACC first, then receive transfer credit at another post-secondary institution. This form (or another with the same content if developed by the partner institution) <u>must</u> be used for all ACC Articulation Agreements.
