Functional Responsibility

Under the general supervision of the Area Supervisor or delegate, will train in the installation, commissioning and maintenance of telecommunications and control equipment related to a power system, leading towards Journeyperson status.

Manitoba Hydro is recruiting candidates for a career in Telecommunications with employment to commence in January and May 2024. Those who currently meet the qualifications, or those who will be graduating with the required qualifications by April 2024 are invited to apply.

Principal Duties

- Assist Telecontrol Technicians in maintenance, installation and commissioning of new equipment.
- Assist in performing emergency service on equipment, making necessary repairs.
- Safely work alone on assigned tasks after gaining the appropriate level of training and experience.
- Participate in and successfully complete the two-year Telecontrol Training Program.
- Required to work and may be stationed at various locations throughout the province.

Qualifications

- A diploma from an accredited Electronic, Computer, or Communications Engineering Technology program or equivalent certification as an Engineering Technologist with the Certified Technicians and Technologists Association of Manitoba (CTTAM)
- Must obtain and maintain a current Personnel Risk Assessment and a "Clear" security rating in accordance with Manitoba Hydro Policy G45D.
- Critical Infrastructure Protection (CIP) Training is required and must be completed prior to transfer date and reviewed annually.

The selection process includes aptitude testing and an interview. Candidates selected for an interview must provide a current driver's abstract at the time of the interview.
