Truck and Transport Mechanics are a key part of a workplace culture that is mutually respectful, productive and engaging within a predominately unionized work environment. This is skilled work at a journeyman level responsible for the overhaul, maintenance, and repair of automobiles, emergency vehicles, public transport, public utility vehicles, light and heavy truck, and construction equipment. Employees work under the leadership of the Fleet Maintenance Chargehand but are allowed considerable latitude for independent judgement in applying knowledge and skills to the diagnosis and repair of assigned equipment.

This position offers a monthly tool allowance, medical and dental benefit plans at a shared cost with the employer, and a pension plan.
