**POSITION TYPE**: Full-Time, Term Position Available (anticipated August 19, 2024 up to March 31, 2025)

**SALARY**: \$62,129 - \$92,271 per annum\*

**POSITION LOCATION**: The successful candidate will teach primarily at a community location in Winnipeg and may also instruct at either the Notre Dame or Exchange District campus.

#### **DUTIES**

Reporting to the Chair, Community Services, Red River College Polytechnic requires a full-time Instructor in the Community Services Department. The successful candidate will primarily instruct the Child and Youth Care Program with the possibility of teaching courses in other programs offered in the department. The Child and Youth Care Program provides graduates with the skills and knowledge to work with children and youth experiencing behavioral and emotional difficulties. Instructor responsibilities include classroom instruction, curriculum development as well as practicum instruction and supervision. The successful candidate will teach primarily at a community location in Winnipeg and may also instruct at either the Notre Dame or Exchange District campus.

## **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS**

- A degree in Child and Youth Care or a related field (including but not limited to Social Work, Family Social Science, Criminal Justice). An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- Extensive experience working with at-risk and vulnerable children and youth
- A thorough knowledge and understanding about the specific role of Child and Youth Care practitioners in the support of Indigenous, newcomer and refugee children, youth, and families
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to use conflict resolution techniques to facilitate positive outcomes
- Demonstrated experience using Microsoft Office Suite
- Ability to work independently as well as in small to large group settings
- Strong presentation skills
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to teach on campus and remotely
- Demonstrated leadership skills
- Experience building a respectful workplace culture that promotes diversity, learning and continuous improvement
