- Organize information on programs, policies, and resources for education;

- Part-take in building policies, strategies, and frameworks based on the research outcomes for Metis citizens in Manitoba;
- Develop online surveys to monitor and assess Metis citizens' experience with the health care system;
- Attend seminars and other meetings as they relate to the project(s);

- Graduate Degree in Health or Social Science, Social Services mandatory, or relevant field, and/or equivalent experience and training may be considered; PhD is an asset;
- Training on multiple research software. SPSS is essential;
- Experience with quantitative/qualitative data, large health related data sets, surveys and community-based research methods;
- Experience in project management;
- Experience in report writing and proposal development;
- Strong, communication, organizational, interpersonal and time management skills;
- Experience working with boards and/or committees is preferred;
- Experience working for a not-for-profit organization and Indigenous community is an asset;
- Knowledge of Métis culture, MMF programs and services is a definite asset; and,
