PURPOSE OF POSITION:

Public-Safety Communications Operator Dispatchers receive emergency and non-emergency calls for Police, Fire, and Ambulance from the public, contact the appropriate responding agency, and provide Fire and Police Dispatch as required.

The City of Brandon is currently accepting applications from former employees of the Brandon Public-Safety Communication Centre who have left the City of Brandon within the last four years and are interested in part-time or full-time employment as a Public-Safety Communications Operator-Dispatcher.

QUALIFICATIONS:
