The MMF seeks to fill **one full-time Climate Specialist** position within our **Energy, Infrastructure and Resource Management Department** located at 200 Main Street in **Winnipeg, MB**. The Climate Specialist oversees the assessment, implementation, management, and monitoring of projects.

#### **Job Duties/Competencies:**

- Prepare reports, briefings, and letters, for review by the Director;
- Research and review all relevant documents, policy, legislation, etc.;
- Research and develop surveys and interview questions on climate concerns;
- Identify survey needs and specific requirements;
- Collect, organize, and analyze information collected and prepare a final report on findings;
- Develop and oversee approved projects;
- Build relationships and communicate with Red River Métis Citizens and Harvesters to expand Community-Based Monitoring Programs;
- Coordinate work associated with the facilitation of meetings, community workshops, teleconferences, etc.

- Degree in Environmental Studies, Natural Resources, Geography, Natural Sciences, Indigenous Studies, and Project Management is considered an asset;
- Experience working in an office, preferably with a non-profit Indigenous organization;
- Experience in community outreach and event organization activities;
- Experience in data research, analysis, and presentation, including report writing;
- Knowledge of historical and current Environmental and Indigenous issues;
- Proficient in Microsoft Office; Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint and Word;
- Strong organizational, interpersonal and time management skills;
- Knowledge of Red River Métis culture, and MMF programs and services is a definite asset; and,
- Ability to travel, valid Manitoba Driver's license with access to a reliable vehicle.
