Duties and Responsibilities:

- Installing sod, dirt, plants (Softscape)
- Installing patios, walls, decks (Hardscape)
- Cutting and measuring of job materials
- Operating small landscaping equipment and tools such as packers, saws, other power tools
- Communicate with foreman effectively for accurate completion of work
- Notify foreman of any tools, equipment and machinery in need of maintenance
- Maintain a clean and safe job site at all times
- Assist foreman with training, record keeping and assigning work tasks to crew members
