This incumbent must successfully communicate and interact with landowners and members, as well as build and promote positive relationships with landowners, RM's and the public by providing a dedicated company contact.

Reporting to the Manager, Surface Land, some specific duties and responsibilities of the **Surface Land Representative** include, but are not limited to:

- Communicate and provide Surface Land/landowner input to the Business Development Teams.
- Incorporate information from the Drilling and Facilities departments to ensure that drilling and right-of-way locations are placed in environmentally acceptable and cost-efficient locations.
- Contact all landowners and occupants with plans for development.
- Act as a liaison between landowners and Tundra.
- Inform, educate, and coordinate all landowner interactions.
- Resolve any issues or complaints from landowner interactions.
- Coordinate all surveying of Surface Leases and Right-of-Ways.
- Negotiate Surface Leases and Right-of-Way Agreements.
- Negotiate surface rental variations.
- Monitor the competition to ensure that competitive compensation is paid to landowners.
- Provide construction packages to Lease Construction consultants.
- Attend and provide input at Master Drill List meetings.
- Maintain GIS database.

Candidates for this position will possess the following qualifications and competencies:

- Post-Secondary Education in Agriculture or Environmental Sciences is an asset.
- Minimum 2 years of negotiating experience in a related field.
- Oilfield production and operations knowledge is considered a definite asset.
